Closest public transport stop: Schottentor

From the station Wien-Mitte/Landstrasse take the underground U4 (direction “Heiligenstadt”) to Schottenring, change to the tram 1 (direction “Stefan-Fadinger-Platz”) or tram 71 (direction “Kaiserebersdorf”) to Schottentor.

Arrival in Vienna

By Airplane

The Vienna International Airport (VIE) in Wien-Schwechat is situated about 20 km south-east of Vienna. On the <https://www.viennaairport.com/en/passengers> you can find flight information as well as transportations into the city center:

- **Local Train: S-Bahn:** to station Wien-Mitte/Landstrasse (takes 24 minutes).

The Local Trains "S-Bahn" to Wien-Mitte/Landstrasse depart every 30 minutes from the airport. Tickets available at ticket machines directly at the station (4.20 Euros) and are valid for connections in Vienna as well (urban railways, underground, tram and bus). From there take the underground U4 to „Schottenring“, then the tram 1 or tram 71 to „Schottentor“.

- **City Airport Train (CAT):** to terminal station Wien-Mitte/Landstrasse (takes 16 minutes).

Departure from the airport every 30 minutes (single ticket online 13.41 Euro / at the ticket machine 14.90 Euros). From there take the underground U4 to „Schottenring“, then the tram 1 or tram 71 to „Schottentor“ (extra ticket required, 2.40 Euros).

- **Taxi from the airport to the conference venue (about 45 Euros).** Some companies provide fixed-price transfer to the city for about 36 Euro. More information at:

By Train

If you prefer travelling by train you will find all the necessary information at the Austrian Federal Railways website (<https://www.oebb.at/en/>) or via phone +43-5-1717.

- from Wien Hauptbahnhof (central station): Tram line D (direction „Nußdorf, Beethovengang“) to „Schottentor“
- from Wien Regionalbahnhof (terminal railway station Wien West): Underground U3 to „Volkstheater“, change there to tram 1 (direction „Prater“) or tram 71 (direction „Schottenring“) and exit at stop „Schottentor“
- from Franz-Josefs-Bahnhof (terminal railway station North-West): Tram line D (direction „Absberggasse“) to stop „Schottentor“
- from Wien-Nord / Praterstern (railway station North): Underground U2 to „Schottentor“

By Car

Coming by car is generally not recommended, as the car will rather be a burden in the city, while public transportation coverage is excellent. If you still want to come by car, here are some general directions. Please use a route planner (such as <http://maps.google.com/>) for more details.

- **from the South and East:** Südbahnhof (A2) – Südosttangente (A23) – Exit Knoten Prater – Schüttelstraße – Untere Donaustraße – Stubenring – Universitätsring
- **from the West:** Westautobahn (A1) – Hietzinger Kai – Wiener Straße – Schönbrunner Straße – Karlsplatz – Opernring – Universitätsring
- **from the North:** Donauuferautobahn (A22) – Südosttangente (A23) – Exit Knoten Prater – Schüttelstraße – Untere Donaustraße – Stubenring – Universitätsring

Please bear in mind that you have to buy the official highway toll label („Vignette“) before using any motorway in Austria (more information at <http://www.asfinag.at/en/home>).

Please also note that public parking is not free of charge in the inner districts of Vienna and it is limited to a maximum of 2 hours per stay. For more information, consult the parking management website of the City of Vienna. There are also underground car parks (Parkgarage Rathauspark) close to the venue, but they are rather costly. <https://www.wien.gv.at/english/transportation/parking/index.htm>

Public Transport in Vienna

Some basic facts about public transportation:

Luckily, all means of public transportation within the city limits can be used with the same ticket:

- **Underground („U-Bahn“)**
- **Urban Railways („S-Bahn“)**
- **Tramway**
- **Bus**

Even a single ticket allows (multiple) connections, but no return trips.

Where do I get a ticket?

Various types of tickets are sold at tobacconists ("Trafik"), at vending machines in underground and S-Bahn stations and in some hotels. Even though there are also other options, it is highly recommended that you buy the ticket before you enter the means of transportation.

There are several types of tickets:

- **Single ticket: (2.40 Euros)**
- **Weekly pass: valid Mo 0:00 a.m. – Mo 9:00 a.m.; transferable (17.10 Euros)**
- **Various tickets: valid for a day or more**
- **Half-price tickets: are required for children (aged 6-15) and dogs**

and

Poster presenters are asked to be next to their poster during the poster sessions.

Lunch

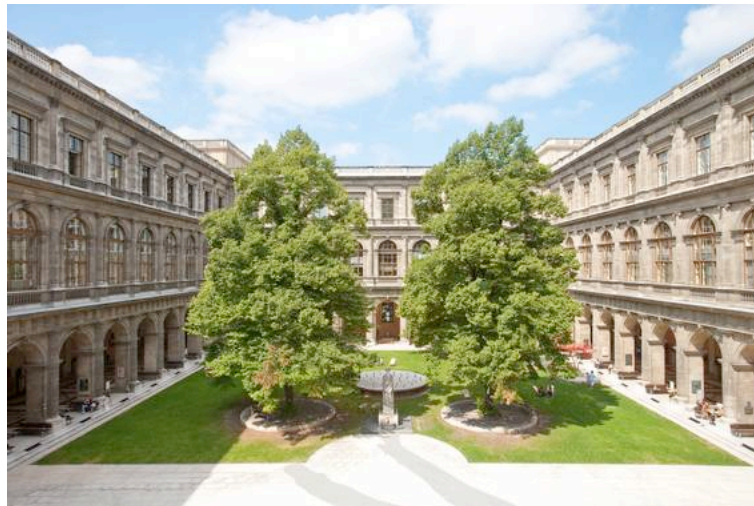

Conference Gala Dinner @ Vienna City Hall



Vienna City Hall (German: Wiener Rathaus) is the seat of local government of Vienna, located on Rathausplatz in the first district. Constructed from 1872 to 1883 in a Neo-Gothic style according to plans designed by Friedrich von Schmidt. The festive hall (German: Festsaal) was built in the late 19th century, the Festival Hall was the biggest hall in the whole country – 71 metres long, 20 metres wide and 18.5 metres high.

Classical Concert @ Austrian Academy of Sciences



The main building of the Austrian Academy of Sciences is located in a baroque building which originally was home of the University of Vienna. The building, designed by the Lorraine architect Jean Nicolas Jardot de Ville-Issey, was erected in 1753-1755. Johann Enzendorfer, Daniel Christoph Dietrich and Johann Adam Münzer carried out its construction. The inauguration by Emperor Franz I. and Empress Maria Theresia took place on April 10th, 1756. Since 1857, it hosts the administration of the Academy and a few of its numerous research units.

This building has a festive hall with an impressive ceiling fresco, which will be the location the concert.

- **Place:** Festsaal
- **Public Transport:** Public transport: tram 1 (direction “Prater”) or U2Z (direction “Schwedenplatz”) to “Schwedenplatz”, then walking to Dr. Ignaz-Seipel Platz 2 – takes approx. 20 min.
- **Walking distance:** approx. 25 min.
